## WHAT IS GAPP

The Georgia Pediatrics Program (GAPP) is a statewide program that provides primary care services to eligible children in Georgia. The program is designed to improve the health and well-being of children by providing comprehensive medical care and other health-related services. GAPP is administered by the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) and is funded by the state of Georgia and the federal government. GAPP provides services to children from birth to age 21 who meet certain eligibility requirements, including being uninsured or underinsured, meeting income guidelines, or having certain medical conditions. Services provided by GAPP include regular check-ups, immunizations, dental care, vision and hearing screenings, and referrals to specialists as needed.

Overall, the goal of GAPP is to ensure that all children in Georgia have access to high-quality healthcare and the support they need to thrive.



## THE KATIE BECKETT WAIVER

The Katie Beckett Waiver, also known as the "Deeming Waiver," allows children under 18 years old to receive Medicaid benefits regardless of their parents' income. Eligibility for the waiver is determined solely by the level of care the child requires in an institutional setting. If a child qualifies for the Katie Beckett Waiver, they can access all services provided by the regular state Medicaid plan, including GAPP services.



## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for GAPP, your child needs to meet specific criteria, which could include being uninsured or underinsured, meeting income limitations, or having particular medical conditions. Eligibility prerequisites can vary based on the particular services required, so we recommend that families reach out to us for additional details.

GAPP utilizes a provider network consisting of various healthcare providers, such as pediatricians, family practitioners, and community health centers, who are committed to delivering top-notch care and collaborating with families to guarantee their children receive the appropriate services.
